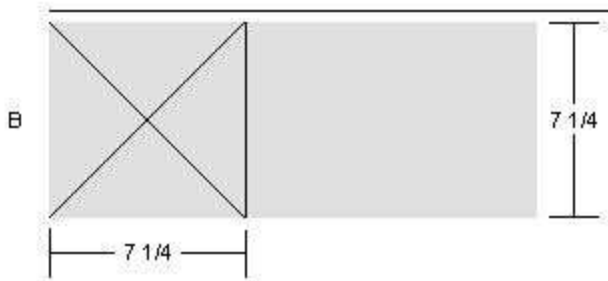
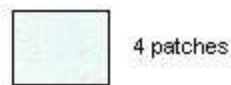
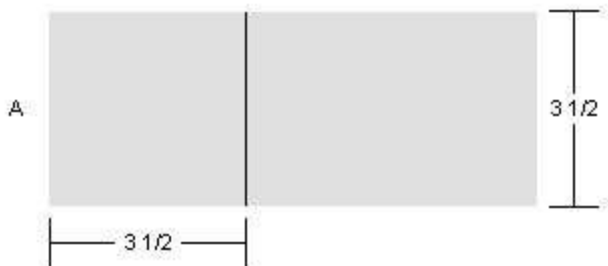
Key Block (1/5 actual size)

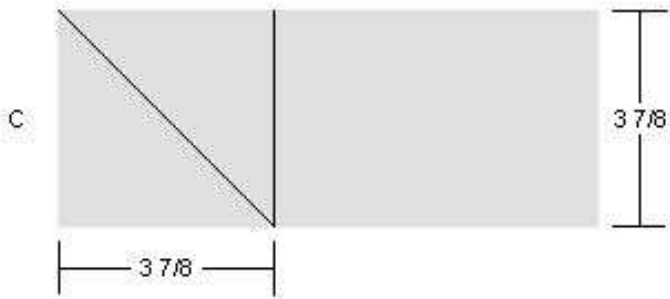


**Make only one block**

Patch Count

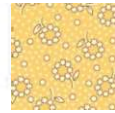
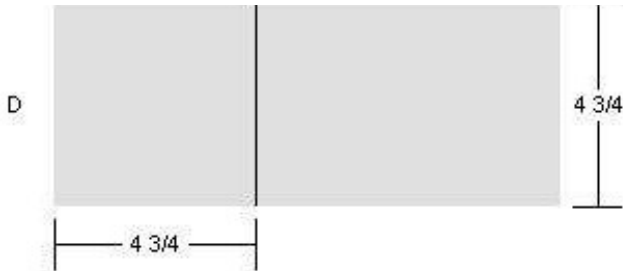




8 patches

- $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam throughout.
- Sew the diagonal edge of the C triangle to the side of the D square right sides together centering both. Repeat on all four sides. You now have an offset square block.
- Sew dark triangle C to Light triangle B along diagonal edge right sides together lining up the blocks along triangle B long straight side. Repeat on other edge of triangle C. (diagram 2) Make 4 total for each block.(Flying Geese Block)

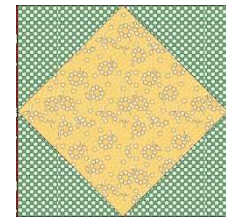


Diagram 2

- Sew light A  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to each end of two of the flying geese blocks. (Diagram 3)

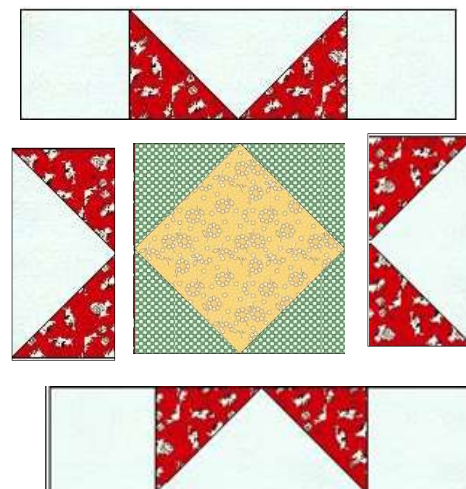


Diagram 3

- Construct the Four Patch Block following diagram 4. Finished block measures  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Make 1 block total.
